## How to Apply for a Harold & Eileen Frasier Memorial Grant

Harold & Eileen Frasier Memorial Grant Applications are accepted throughout the year to be used to support projects, activities, and/or charitable causes that enhance the **LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT** and betterment of rural life in **Wallace County, Kansas** and the surrounding area. Applications must be made through the foundation's online grant portal.

This fund was established in 2014 by the children of Harold and Eileen Frasier, who were longtime residents and passionate supporters of rural life in Wallace County, Kansas and the surrounding area.

**Grants must be applied for by a qualified charitable organization. Individuals not working with a qualified charitable organization will not be eligible to receive grant funds.** Grants are paid to the organization. Eligible organizations:

- 501(c)(3) charitable nonprofit organization,
- Educational Institution (School or K-State Extension & Research Districts),
- Government Organization (City or County government), or
- Religious Organizations.

Before applying, you will need to obtain approval from an eligible organization to submit a grant application. When you create a user account on the grant portal, you will need the organization's name, address, and federal ID number to create your account. If you have an existing user account, please contact GNWKCF at [grants@gnwkcf.org](mailto:grants@gnwkcf.org) or 785-734-2406 to request that your account be added to the eligible organization. Proof of approval to apply is required as part of the grant application.

**All recipients are REQUIRED to present your leadership experience with Wallace County Foundation or an approved Civic Organization.**

This is an overview of how to apply online for a grant through the grant portal

This site is not completely compatible with Safari (Mac / Apple browsers).*

Log onto the online grant portal using the user account you have created.

- After an account is created, click on the **APPLY** button at the top of the dashboard.
- Enter the ACCESS CODE: **Frasier** (capital F)
- Then click **"Enter Code"**.
- Answer all questions and upload any documentation requested.
- Click **Submit Application**
- Click **Continue** to return to the Dashboard.
