How to Apply

Visit **rcacf.org** and click on the **Grants** tab. Please apply at least two weeks before the activity begins.

Important Information

- Applications are reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
- Financial need must be demonstrated.
- Grant payments are made directly to the activity provider on behalf of the child.
- Funds may only be awarded to qualified charitable entities including schools, churches, nonprofits, or other charitable organizations. For-profit business providers are not eligible.
